

Government Notice No. 129 of 2024

THE ALLIED HEALTH PROFESSIONALS COUNCIL ACT

**Regulations made by the Minister, after consultation with
the Allied Health Professionals Council, under section
39 of the Allied Health Professionals Council Act**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Allied Health Professionals Council (Amendment of Schedule) Regulations 2024.
2. In these regulations –
“Act” means the Allied Health Professionals Council Act.
3. The First Schedule to the Act is repealed and replaced by the First Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.
4. These regulations shall come into operation on 12 August 2024.

3. Any person who has undergone only online courses may apply to the Council for registration within 6 months from the coming into operation of these regulations and the Council shall determine his application on being satisfied that the online course contents are to the satisfaction of the Council and that he also meets the requirements of section 17 of the Act.
